102 انجليزي 1802102

This intermediate English course is a continuation of the previous multiskill English course 101. It aims at further consolidation of the four language skills through more sophisticated teaching material. In addition, the course will focus on the construction and usage of non-complex sentences, comparison of adjectives and adverbs, clauses, wh-questions, gerunds and infinitives.

قواعد اللغة الإنجليزية 0202104

This course concentrates on grammatical categories, i.e. parts of speech. The noun phrase, verb phrase, adjectives & adverbs, and prepositions are studied in depth.

(1) قراءة 0202105

The primary objective of this course is to further improve student reading skills and help them acquire the reading strategies that are appropriate for dealing with literary and non-literary texts. Such skills and strategies include guessing word meanings, extracting main ideas, understanding text organization, predicting, checking comprehension, linking ideas, inferring, writing responses, etc.

(1) كتابة 0202106

This course aims at teaching students how to write a coherent and unified paragraph. The course should provide the students with the necessary techniques to write correct and effective sentences. It also aims at teaching students how to observe correct punctuation. This course also aims at teaching students how to write topic sentences and how to develop such sentences into

complete paragraphs. In addition, different paragraph patterns, such as classifying, contrasting, and analyzing, etc. should be addressed.

استيعاب ومحادثة 0202109

The aim of this course is to help students reinforce and extend their listening and conversational skills. This is achieved through providing them with systematic and comprehensive training in the perception and production of English utterances of various types and lengths. Particular attention is given to stress, rhythm, and the more important types of word linking. Formality levels, conversational syntax, and turn-taking rules are also emphasized. Highfrequency introductory, transitional, and concluding elements of different communicative events should be discussed and intensively drilled, so that they may become part of the student's conversational repertoire.

(2) استيعاب ومحادثة (2) 0202121

It is an extension of 0202109.

قراءة متقدمة 0202205

This course is designed to improve students' critical reading and thinking skills. Through the texts and the exercises, students will be trained how to increase analytical, inferential, and evaluative comprehension, expand vocabulary skills, and employ effective reading strategies to read texts of different genres and disciplines.

كتابه (2) 0202206

The main objective of this course is to enable students to express themselves coherently in writing. It exposes students to, and gives them practice in, extended writing beyond the sentence and paragraph levels, i.e. writing an essay. The course should also focus on the organization of academic writing (e.g. reports, essays, assignments and projects), its structure, and, particularly, the ways in which all parts are linked together. The main objectives of the course can be achieved through practice inside and outside the classroom.

مقدمة في الأدب 0202211

The aim of the course is to introduce students to the concept and definition of "literature", and to the three major genres: poetry, fiction, and drama. Students will be exposed to elements, distinctive qualities, and salient features of each genre. The discussion will be centered on stories, poems, and one or two one-act plays.

تاريخ أدب 0202212

The aim of the course is to familiarize students with the different eras and movements of English literature from Chaucer to the present. The course primarily emphasizes historical, political, religious, and social events that have helped to shape English literature and thought.

مقدمة في اللغويات 0202221

The course aims at acquainting students with the nature of language and its fundamental aspects, including the basics of phonetics, phonology, morphology, syntax, and semantics.

(1) نحو 0202222

This course aims at providing students with a basic introduction to generative syntax. Basically, the course covers the fundamentals of generative syntax (rules, trees, parts of speech, constituency, structural relations, binding theory), the base of generative syntax (X-bar theory), and basic transformations (Head-to-Head movement, NP/DP movement, Wh-movement, raising, control, and empty categories).

علم الدلالة 0202303

This course offers an introduction to the basic concepts and methods in the analysis of natural language meaning through a survey of major current approaches and their findings: structuralist semantics, cognitive semantics, referential semantics, and radical pragmatics. Topics of focal interest include: semantics at the language-cognition interface; lexical semantics, construction meaning, and syntax; semantics, pragmatics, and interaction; semantic typology and universals.

قواعد مقدمة 0202304

This course aims at teaching students English complex structures as a continuation of 0202104. Greater details, especially in the area of complex phrases, clauses and sentences are supplied.

(1) رواية 0202308

This course is an introduction to the novel as a literary genre from its beginnings to the present. Students will learn to identify the basic characteristics of prose fiction, such as point-of-view, plot, and characterization. Through intensive study of selected novels representing a variety of periods and subgenres, main trends in fiction, and the contribution of major novelists, the students should demonstrate an understanding of the historical, aesthetic, and

literary aspects of the novel through both oral and written assignments.

(1) شعر 0202310

This course introduces students to the major poets and subgenres of poetry from various periods, beginning with the Middle Ages and ending with postmodernism. Through intensive study of selections of poetry, students show understanding of terms such as rhyme, meter, image, symbol, tone, and persona.

قصة قصيرة 0202316

The course is intended to introduce students to the short story as a genre originated in the 19th century. Some ten short stories will be selected to represent different techniques, themes, and subjects.

الصوتيات 0202322

The aim of this course is to introduce students to the field of general phonetics: the production, transmission, and perception of sounds as physical entities. Emphasis throughout the course is on the sounds of English and suprasegmental features. Students are given ample practice in the language lab.

(1) مسرحية 0202326

This course introduces students to dramatic literature through the study of plays which represent various genres (e.g. tragedies, comedies, etc.) and a variety of periods (e.g. Greek, modern, etc.). Students will develop critical judgement and learn to analyze the structure and the content of the plays they

read.

(1) ترجمة 0202332

The aim of this course is to introduce students to the basic principles and techniques of translation with simultaneous training on translation from Arabic into English and vice versa. Texts to be translated are to reflect various types of registers and styles.

النقد الأدبي 0202412

This is an advanced course intended primarily to introduce students to some literary theories, principles, and interests of criticism. The course also includes a brief introduction to the history of literary theory and its major concerns.

(2) ترجمة 0202432

This course is a continuation of Eng. 322 (Translation I), but of more advanced nature. In this course students are exposed to different registers and styles: scientific, military, literary etc... Class exercises and home assignments include translation of a number of passages of various length and critiques of translations.

ترجمة عسكرية 0202440

This course trains students to translate texts in military contexts from English into Arabic and vice versa. They are also trained to translate live dialogues in real military contexts.

الكتاب 0202437

The aim of this course is to survey some background information related to current issues dominating the research in second language acquisition (SLA). The topics in this course may include: theories of SLA, the Contrastive Analysis Hypothesis, Error Analysis, factors affecting SLA (e.g., age, critical period, motivation, personality, first language, neurological aspects, etc.,), strategies of language learning, and the contribution of SLA research to language teaching.

اللغة الإنجليزية لأغراض عسكرية 0202460

This course introduces students to the basic terms used in the military contexts through exposing them to authentic related texts. They will also be trained to use the terms correctly and appropriately.

اللغة الإنجليزية للقانون والسياسة 0202470

This course introduces students to the basic terms used in the contexts of law and politics through exposing them to authentic related texts. They will also be trained to use the terms correctly and appropriately.
