1- WITNESSETH: to be read as:

WHEREAS, The COLLEGE desires that Doctor of Medicine who commences their final academic year (hereinafter referred to as "STUDENTS"), obtain elective clinical training course of eight weeks in two major disciplines – 4 weeks for each discipline , OR, 4 weeks in one major discipline; during the summer term of the academic year of the COLLEGE (hereinafter referred as "ELECTIVE COURSE") at the AGENCY ; and

2- WITNESSETH.6. E.

"Associate Dean of Clinical Education" to be replaced by: "The Vice Dean for Clinical Affairs and the Dean Assistant for Hospital affairs".

3- WITNESSETH.8. E. and WITNESSETH.8. F:

These parts should be deleted from the college responsibilities and to be considered as students' responsibilities.

4- INSURANCE COVARAGE AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR NEGLIGENCE

This is a responsibility of the students and read as :

"12. The student shall be liable for damage or injury.....Student agrees to indemnify and hold harmlessof acts or omissions by Students. in that regard, the STUDENTS agrees to maintain during the term of this Agreement....."

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT ,entered into this 11th day of Feb, 2019 by and between **Faculty of medicine-Mutah University** (hereinafter referred to as “COLLEGE”) and **Heritage Valley Health System/ Ohio Valley Hospital** (hereinafter referred to as “AGENCY”).

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the COLLEGE desires that students enrolled in its graduate program leading to the degree of Doctor of Medicine (hereinafter referred to as “STUDENTS”) , obtain clinical experience at the AGENCY ; and

WHEREAS , the AGENCY is willing to provide the necessary HOSPITAL facilities for said clinical experience in recognition of the need to train medical students

NOW ,THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the promises and the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained , the parties hereto agree as follows :

1. The Board of Trustees of the AGENCY shall continue as the governing body of the AGENCY and the Board of Trustees of the COLLEGE shall continue as the governing body of the COLLEGE in accordance with their respective Charters, Constitution and Bylaws in effect at the time of the execution of this agreement

2. The Dean of the COLLEGE or his/her designate and the C.E.O of the AGENCY or his/her designate shall serve on a day-to-day basis to supervise the administration of terms and conditions of this Agreement. In the case of any disagreement, the matter shall be referred for resolutions to the dean of the COLLEGE and the C.E.O of the AGENCY



3. The AGENCY shall make its premises, facilities and services available for the medical training and education of STUDENTS who have been accepted by the COLLEGE.

4. The COLLEGE shall be solely responsible for any and all appointments to its faculty and the AGENCY shall be solely responsible for any and all appointments to its medical staff.

5. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to affect or restrain members of the medical staff of the AGENCY in their access to AGENCY services or facilities of the AGENCY.

6. The medical training and education conducted at the AGENCY for COLLEGE STUDENTS shall be subject to the following:

A. All clinical faculty of the AGENCY providing training and education on AGENCY'S premises and all COLLEGE'S STUDENTS receiving such education and training shall at all time comply with pertinent federal, state and local statutes and regulations which relate to any service rendered by said faculty or STUDENTS to AGENCY patients.

B. COLLEGE agrees To require each STUDENT and faculty member to comply with all AGENCY'S policies, rules, regulations, bylaws and procedures and to maintain the confidentiality of all patient information obtained and observations made in the usual parameters observed in medical education. Should any STUDENT or faculty member of the COLLEGE contravene any AGENCY policy, rule, regulation, by law or procedure or violate it in its discretion, require immediate removal of said STUDENT or faculty member from medical training and education programs provided at the AGENCY and shall immediately



notify the dean of the COLLEGE. When this occurs, any remaining dispute or disagreement shall be resolved by a conference of the C.E.O or his/her designate of the AGENCY and the dean of the COLLEGE.

C. All STUDENTS of The COLLEGE and clinical faculty of the AGENCY are expected to comply with the "Standards of Excellence" which are attached hereto and incorporated herein as Addendum A, during their affiliation with the AGENCY. Failure to do so may result in the dismissal of the STUDENT or instructor of the AGENCY.

D. STUDENTS shall participate by taking medical history , performing physical examination, making permissible chart notations, aiding in such patient management , diagnosis and therapy as may be permitted , and participating in other activities as allowed by the AGENCY'S Medical Director and/or the Director of medical education as assigned by the faculty member in charge. Patient's histories, physical examinations, and other notes as recorded by the STUDENTS participating in the AGENCY's teaching program may become part of the AGENCY records as determined by the AGENCY. These entries shall be identified by the STUDENTS signature and COLLEGE class shall be reviewed and countersigned by the appropriate supervising faculty member of the COLLEGE and/or the attending physician, if different.

E. Determination of clinical rotations available for STUDENTS of the COLLEGE will be made by the C.E.O and his/her designee of the AGENCY and the Dean of the COLLEGE or their designees. Assignment of the STUDENTS, based on this determination, will be made by the COLLEGE through its Associate Dean of Clinical Education.



F. The duties of the AGENCY'S clinical faculty with regards to the clinical experience of the STUDENT shall include:

- (1) Direct instructions and supervision of the STUDENT.
- (2) Periodic evaluation of the STUDENTS progress as required by the COLLEGE.

G. The COLLEGE faculty will make regular visits to the AGENCY, when feasible, or meet to confer regularly with the AGENCY C.E.O and his/her designee in order to coordinate the progress of the course instruction and to determine its effectiveness.

7. No patient in the AGENCY will be made party to any research project of the COLLEGE, willingly or unwillingly, without the advance approval of the research program and protocol by the C.E.O. or his/her designee and Medical Director of the AGENCY and without strict adherence to the defined procedures and protocols of the research program

8. The COLLEGE agrees:

- (A) To inform the staff of the AGENCY as the extent of the STUDENTS academic preparation for the purposes of assignment of the STUDENTS to the appropriate level of clinical experience

(B) To assume responsibility for the educational experience and final grades of the STUDENTS

(C) To fully cooperate in good faith with AGENCY, including if there is litigation pertaining to a patient whom STUDENT has participated in the care

(D) To educate each STUDENT as to his/her responsibilities pursuant to this AGREEMENT, and continuing after the expiration of this AGREEMENT

(E) To provide the AGENCY-upon the AGENCY'S request – with the STUDENTS “Immunization Status Report” (hereinafter “IS report”). See ADDENDUM B to view the tests, vaccines, and attestations contained with each IS report

→ To Delete

(F) To provide the AGENCY -upon the AGENCY'S request- with the STUDENTS “OSHA & Personal Health Care Insurance Information Report” (hereinafter, “O&P Report”). See ADDENDUM C to view the safety programs and health care insurance information contained with each O&P Report

9. The COLLEGE agrees to provide in-kind services to the AGENCY in the form of in-service education sessions, or other educational opportunities as mutually agreed upon by the institutions.

10. STUDENTS shall be ultimately responsible for the cost of medical care and treatment needed by them; however, initial emergency outpatient medical care and initial treatment for injuries sustained while in the performance of their duties at the AGENCY will be rendered from the AGENCY to the individual STUDENT and AGENCY shall bill STUDENT'S health insurance policy for the individual STUDENT and AGENCY shall bill STUDENT'S health insurance policy for all reasonable costs incurred for said treatment. In offering this initial emergency outpatient care, the AGENCY assume no liability for any condition or incident necessitating the treatment rendered. The AGENCY does not assume responsibility for any third party sources. The AGENCY does not assume responsibility for any charges by any private physician for any care rendered to the STUDENT while in said AGENCY. The STUDENT shall be responsible for all medical care charges incurred, both to hospital and physician, that may be rendered as a result of an injury sustained while performing his or her duties at the AGENCY

11. Arrangement for lodging and meals will be at the discretion of the AGENCY.

**SPECIFIC COLLABORATION AGREEMENT FOR THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE AND
ODONTOLOGY BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF VALENCIA AND THE UNIVERSITY OF
MUTAH**

Dr _____, Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and Odontology of Valencia, on behalf of and representing the University, in exercising the competencies granted by Article 94.1 of the Statutes of the University of Valencia approved by Decree 128/2004, of 30 June, located at Avda. Blasco Ibáñez, 13, 46100 Valencia (Spain)

AND

Dr. _____, on behalf of and representing _____, exercising the competencies granted by _____, located at

Are involved in accordance with their respective posts and exercise their signatory powers on behalf of the entities that they represent, and for such purpose

DECLARE

That on the date _____ both institutions signed a Framework Collaboration Agreement, which is valid and whose declarations are stated herein.

That it was agreed upon to collaborate in tasks of mutual interest, which are to be approved by both institutions and formalised by Specific Agreements that are signed within the framework of such document.

That the Faculty of Medicine and Odontology at the University of Valencia and the Faculty of Medical Sciences... at Mutah University..... have fields of common interest. Aware of the importance to strengthen their interuniversity relationship, they agree to combine efforts through the signature of this Collaboration Agreement with the following:

CLAUSES

1. The Agreement aims to establish the terms and conditions between both institutions in order to carry out the following activities:
 - a. The exchange of medical fellows for a period of ... years in different clinical specialties.
 - b. The academic collaboration through the admission of Professors and/or Researchers of the clinical sciences at each institution for a period of time, which will be determined by both institutions. For instance, short term (1 / 2 weeks) staff exchange for lecturing purposes in selected areas of strength.
 - c. The collaboration on research projects of interest to both sides that enable to exchange expertise for a short period, determined accordingly, in available facilities, services and materials.
 - d. Student exchange program: 10 students in the last year will be accepted to have a visiting situation for a 4 week period between June-August every year.

2. For the academic coordination of this specific Agreement each university shall appoint a representative. The University of Valencia appoints Prof. Joaquim Ortega Ferrando and the University of Murcia appoints (name and position within the Central Programme).

3. The Academic coordinators are responsible for implementing institutional collaboration activities that are necessary to achieve the proposed objectives in coordination with the corresponding units in each institution, as well as the preparation and issuance of a report assessing the knowledge and skills acquired by the participants during their stay at the host university.

4. Each party shall select the medical fellows and/or scientists who will participate in the exchange programme set forth in this Agreement, in accordance with the procedures and requirements established by the host university. Selected candidates shall have the

level of language knowledge required by the host university, and the postgraduate academic level.

5. This Agreement does not entail financial commitments or economic obligations. For the University of Valencia, funding shall be obtained by official public calls for that purpose and official calls by the University of Valencia, or other institutions involved in the activity. Sending Institutions will be responsible for the financial support of respective fellows and/or scientists. The University of Mutah will fund those incoming clinical specialist required for a specific tutorial work. 6.

7. The Faculty of Medicine and Odontology will provide to Incoming Fellows, Professors and Scientists a complete Transcript of Records with performed activities ~~which~~ signed by the Coordinator for International Relations and Exchange Programs of the receiving Institution.

8. This Agreement shall last four (4) years and shall be extended automatically for equal time periods, except if express complaint is made within three (3) months prior to completion and without detriment to the completion of activities taking place at that time.

9. Any unforeseen issue or discrepancy in this Agreement shall be resolved by the parties by mutual agreement, if necessary, by annexes that make up part of the Agreement and must be approved by the competent bodies of each university.



Bambino Gesu' Pediatric Hospital (OPBG), owned by the Holy See:

- Created in 1869 and Formally recognized by the Italian Ministry of Health as 'Istituto di Ricovero e Cura a Carattere Scientifico (IRCCS-Research Hospital) in 1985.
