EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

I have teaching responsibilities for both medical students and ophthalmology residents.

As for medical students, I give 18 lectures per rotation the rotation is repeated every month, mainly the course is an introduction to ophthalmology (anatomy, physiology of the eye, clinical lectures like retinal diseases, corneal disease etc.). In the clinic 2-4 students shadow me, and I try to teach them simple principles of ophthalmology like how to use the ophthalmoscope, RAPD, motility exam ... etc.

As for the residents; we have currently 4 residents in first, second and thirds training years in ophthalmology. We have a good and solid program teaching both Basic and clinical Sciences in ophthalmology. We try to give them 4 hours of lectures a week. They shadow me in the clinic and the operating theater, we try our best to teach them how to deal with ophthalmology conditions, and I personally teach them the medical retina and the Oculoplastic part of ophthalmology.

We have a weekly journal club and a case discussion, presented by the residents.

Since Feb/ 2011, I was held course director for the residency program at Mutah University. I am trying to develop a wet lab for our residents, increase the amount of surgeries done by each resident.

The department is very keen on conducting various research projects. We have managed to publish some pioneer publications and epidemiological publications.
