Job Jo is aiming to reduce unemployment and poverty in remote areas in Jordan through the establishment of multiple Business Bureaus in the participating higher education institutions. These Bureaus will provide the necessary teaching and training services for unemployed graduates and requalify them to increase their job opportunities. Job Jo also claims to have a special focus on women. The foreseen outcomes will effectively contribute to improving the capacity building process at the national level and to allow graduates to gain the skills and training needed for their profession.

Moreover, the foreseen activities will surely foster economic growth and reduce unemployment and poverty in remote areas. Job Jo aims include providing services and workshops to graduates to gain skills which are necessary, but not commonly provided by universities. In addition, Job Jo will promote the modernization of learning methods, training of staff and students, management and quality control and internationalization of higher education institutions. The priority addressed is a relevant national priority for the Jordan.







This event featured the JOBJO project along with other projects.





Training Internship For Jordanian Students - Cyprus

June 22nd - July 4th 2022

An Internship for more than 10 Students has been conducted at University of Cyprus

UCY hosted a two week intensive student training for the Erasmus+project JobJo. 15 students from Universities from Jordan visited and following the training.

Dr. Thomas Fotiades gave a lecture about Useful Digital Tools. He explained how to create a google form, its usefulness, as well as ways and aims of creating a survey evaluation, and how to analyze the collected results. Evangelia Vanezi gave a lecture about Secure web browsing and Privacy. She presented a brief summary of the main dangers when browsing the web or communicating via emails and then concentrated on the Phishing attack. A case study of such an attack was demonstrated in the lecture. Privacy was discussed through the provisions and rights of the GDPR. As an assignment, the students had to create a google form survey, gather some data and present them, as well as investigate and present a phishing attack case study. The students completed and presented their assignments and projects successfully. The two-day session was completed with the Certificates that were given to all participants.

The intensive student training for the Erasmus+ project JobJo, continues with the 15 students from Jordan participating and attending a variety of interesting activities. On Friday the students got to visit the UCY Recording Studio and the team of experts there explained to them the procedure for recording videos: where to stand, how cameras and microphones work, where they can read their words from, and so on. They also attended two very interesting lectures by Dr Constantinos Tsouris and Aggeliki Tziongkourou. All the above in the preparation for creating their own video CVs, presenting themselves. On Monday the students visited again the recording studio, where they recorded their individual videos.

- 3. University Clinic-Leipzig















The 9th Management Meeting Quality Meeting

JOBJO Project Final Conference

• July 7th, 2022

The activities of the closing conference of the Job JO project, one of the capacity building projects supported by Erasmus Plus and supported by the European Union, were concluded at Mutah University on Thursday.

He urged the President of Mutah University, Prof. Arafat Awajan, to engage in such projects that enhance capacity-building in Jordanian universities, praising the efforts of participants in the conference, such as the Civil Service Commission, the Greater Karak Municipality and Umniah Company.

According to the Director of the Erasmus Plus National Office, Prof. Ahmed Abu Al-Heija, a large number of participants in the project have enrolled in training courses within universities and international scientific institutions, which is a translation of the close relations between them.
